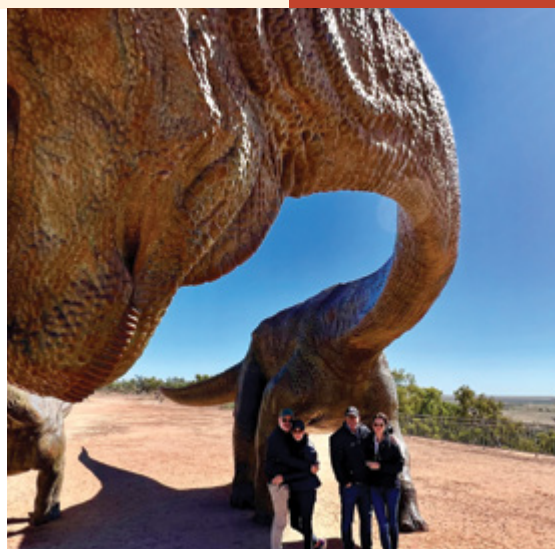

DAY ONE: TUESDAY 13 JUNE 2023

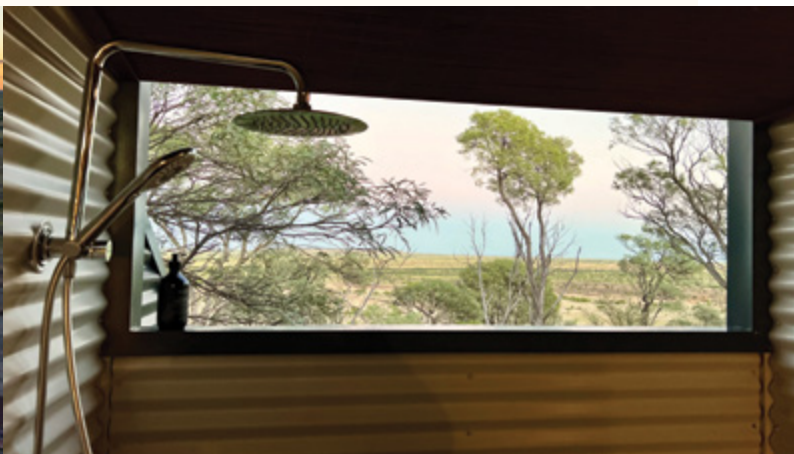
DAY THREE: THURSDAY 15 JUNE 2023
