3 NIGHT 2026 WINTON OPAL FESTIVAL ITINERARY

DAY ONE | FRIDAY 10th JULY 2026

Arrive in Winton and transfer to Rangelands Outback Camp, set atop a striking mesa on a private cattle station. Check into your super-sized luxury ensuite tent, thoughtfully designed for comfort and privacy, and take in sweeping views across classic "dinosaur country". Late afternoon, join fellow guests on the Sunset Deck for signature sunset drinks and cheese platter as the colours of the outback shift with the setting sun. Enjoy a chef-prepared gourmet dinner, paired with fine wines and premium beers, before settling in for a relaxed evening under the stars, far from city lights. (D)

DAY TWO | SATURDAY 11th JULY 2026

Wake to an outback sunrise and enjoy a relaxed, chef-prepared breakfast before heading into town using the scheduled shuttle service. Today is yours to immerse yourself in the Winton Opal Festival, a prestigious biennial event held in the heart of Queensland's renowned Boulder Opal region. Hosted on Winton's Main Street and organised by the Queensland Boulder Opal Association, the festival attracts professional dealers, designers and opal enthusiasts from across Australia and beyond. Browse an impressive showcase of opal products – from raw stones to polished gems and beautifully crafted jewellery – and gain insight into the opal industry that has shaped Winton's economy and cultural heritage since the late 19th century. A festival highlight is the Queen of Gems Design Awards, celebrating originality, craftsmanship and contemporary design using Queensland Boulder Opal. While in town, you may also choose to visit the Waltzing Matilda Centre or join an optional tour to the nearby Australian Age of Dinosaurs (own arrangements for lunch). Return to Rangelands early afternoon for sunset drinks, followed by another gourmet dinner at the camp. (B,D)

DAY THREE | SUNDAY 12th JULY 2026

After another delicious chef-prepared breakfast, set off on an exclusive full-day tour to Opalton with Savannah Guide host - Red Dirt Tours. Travel south of Winton to the historic opal mining settlement of Opalton, made famous through the television series Outback Opal Hunters. On arrival, meet a local Opal miner and explore the old town site and surrounding opal fields. Learn how opal is formed, the different types of opal found in the region, and the methods used to mine them. Try your hand at fossicking for opals before enjoying a relaxed BBQ lunch in this remote and fascinating landscape. Return to Rangelands by approximately 4.30pm, in time for one final sunset over the mesa. Celebrate your last evening with sunset drinks, followed by a farewell gourmet dinner – the perfect conclusion to your outback opal experience. (B,L,D)

DAY FOUR | MONDAY 13th JULY 2026

Savour a final relaxed breakfast at Rangelands before transferring to Winton for your homeward bound arrangements. *Please note: Your Rangelands hosts will confirm timing for the Rangelands Rifts Guided walk (B)
